Riverboat Development Authority awards grants

The Board of Directors of the Riverboat Development Authority approved \$926,400.00 in awards at their meeting this morning.

The largest grant was a leadership grant of \$100,000 to the newly formed QC Chamber.

Programs for children and youth in the community include grants for Coats for Kids, Big Brothers Big Sisters, Boys & Girls Clubs, Child Abuse Prevention and Services and the Children's Therapy Center.

The QC Food Hub received seed money to begin implementing the plan recently adopted by the Davenport Levee Commission. Other grants to complement the Food Hub went to Scott County Extension for demonstration gardens and to the new Scott Community College Culinary Program.

The grants awarded today bring the total of awards from the RDA to \$50,628,766.00
