PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT: HOUSING FAMILIES AND HOUSING YOUTH

Bethany for Children & Families provides transitional housing services for families, young adults, and teens in the Quad Cities who are experiencing homelessness.

The Housing Families and Housing Youth programs are built on the Housing First model, providing permanent, affordable housing as quickly as possible and then surrounding families and youth with services and community connections to build long-term stability.

Bethany serves families with little to no income who often face challenges related to mental health, substance use, or generational poverty. Families are placed in neighborhoods that minimize disruption to work, school, and support networks whenever possible. Immediate needs are addressed, and intensive case management helps families tackle the root causes of homelessness.

Bethany serves youth aging out of foster care, emancipated minors, homeless teens, young adults, and single-parent teens. As stability grows, clients progressively assume responsibility for their own living expenses. Participants are expected to: secure employment or increase income, complete educational opportunities, maintain permanent housing, and develop leadership, responsibility, and community engagement skills.

Bethany welcomes donations to support families moving into their homes. Needed items include:

- **Kitchen:** dish towels, utensils, pots & pans, plates, cups, bowls, trash cans
- **Bathroom:** shower curtain liners & rings, bath towels, plungers, toilet brushes, toilet paper
- **Cleaning Supplies:** bleach, sponges, paper towels, glass cleaner, mop, broom & dustpan, mop bucket, oven cleaner, disinfectant wipes & spray, all-purpose cleaner, vacuums
- **Bedroom:** pillows, comforters, sheets, pillow cases
